





Certified ORB Auditors are trained and licensed by the Organisation for Responsible Businesses before they can carry out Responsible Business Standard audits.

Training includes the full day on site training followed by post-training submission of a mock audit report which will be assessed prior to a license being issued.

The Training Day

The cost of the Training Day is excellent value at £275 (all prices are plus VAT). This includes lunch and refreshments throughout the day.

EARLY BIRD DISCOUNTS provide even better options:

- ◆ £185 + vat if booked and paid by 20th May 2015.
- ◆ Alternatively Secure your place with a £50 + vat deposit paid by 13th May and pay a balance of £160 + vat by 8th June.

The Training Day is a one-off commitment. Ongoing training, if required, will normally be virtual (via online or conference call methods) and will not generally be chargeable.

There is also an annual licensing fee which is in two parts:

Annual Licensing Fee

Part 1 : Membership and Associate Membership of ORB is required for the company, which is £120 + vat for businesses with up to 5 employees. (There are also monthly payment options available.) Rates for bigger companies can be found on the ORB website www.orbuk.org.uk.

Only one company membership is required regardless of the number of individual consultants being trained.

The questionnaire part of the membership process must be completed at the time of initial registration with payment due at least two weeks before the Training Day. All normal Membership and Associate Membership benefits apply.

Part 2 : An individual annual license fee of £75 + vat which will be invoiced once all stages of training have been passed.

How much could you earn?

Auditors will be self-employed and will be paid per audit starting at approximately £500 for an office-based micro company, taking approximately 4 hours on site plus admin time to complete the audit report. Rates etc. will increase pro-rate according to the size and complexity of the company. There is also a commission structure for referral of businesses for basic ORB membership.

It is important to note that you will be able to work with your clients before and / or after an audit on your normal consultancy basis. We believe that to really embed change it is essential to build close client relationships, thereby making the opportunity and earning potential very cyclical. All we ask is that any such relationships are registered on the auditors portal to ensure transparency.

Once your application is approved, payment can be made by cheque, BACS or debit / credit card.
